CDHO is committed to using evidence-based research to set the highest possible practice standards to facilitate safe, effective and accessible dental hygiene care for the public of Ontario. Among the largest of the regulatory health care Colleges in Canada, CDHO regulates over 12,000 practitioners and promotes competent, ethical practice in dental hygiene.

The College is seeking a Registrar to lead this dynamic, proactive organization. Reporting through the President to a council composed of elected dental hygienists and public representatives appointed by the Ontario Ministry of Health and Long Term Care, the Registrar is responsible for implementing strategic directions, liaising with stakeholders, and providing leadership to a team-based staff of 17. The strategic directions include initiatives relating to public awareness, public access to oral health care, quality education, the future of the profession, and leadership as a regulatory College on key issues such as national standards.

The Registrar is further accountable for proposing and operationalizing strategy; representing the College to stakeholders; understanding, implementing and explaining relevant legislation and regulation including the Regulation Health Professions Act and Dental Hygiene Act; ensuring

effective development and deployment of financial and human resources; working with committees and other staff to develop and implement standards and guidelines for the profession; and providing governance support to Council.

You are familiar with Ontario's current health care landscape and policy issues, and possess the exceptional communications skills required to establish effective working relationships with public, government, academic, regulatory and association stakeholders.
